3. Criteria

- a. Nominees will be evaluated on the basis of demonstrated commitment to the concerns of women and families within the labor movement and beyond
- b. Factors that will be considered are one or more of the following:
 - i. Dedication to the advancement of CSEA Women's goals within the labor movement and/or the public sector
 - ii. Volunteerism and/or community service
 - iii. Outstanding job performance
 - iv. Other criteria such as: outstanding achievements related to women/family/humanitarian contributions/activism or other special qualities

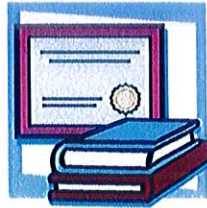

Women and Education Committee Scholarship
Three (3) - \$1,000 AWARDS

The Women & Education Committee of CSEA Local 830 is awarding three (3) scholarships. The Women and Education Committee addresses issues which benefit women and families. Our goals are to raise social awareness and to further educate our membership.

Eligibility:

- a) A CSEA Local 830 bargaining unit member, in good standing, enrolled in an "Accredited" 2 or 4 year college or vocational school.
- b) A student who is a child of, or in the legal custody or guardianship of a CSEA Local 830 bargaining unit member, in good standing, and who is either:
 1. A graduating high school senior to be enrolled in an accredited 2 or 4 year college or vocational school; or
 2. A college student, in good standing, enrolled in an accredited 2 or 4 year college or vocational school.
- c) Maintains not less than a cumulative "B", 80%, or a 3.0 grade point average.

Criteria:

- a) Career goals in social/behavioral sciences, health field, legal, or related fields with the intent of furthering issues that are relevant to working women and their families.

Application requirements:

- a) Typed essay (no less than 250 words but not to exceed 400 words) to include: school activities, community involvement, career goals, how CSEA has influenced your life and the work your parent or guardian does in CSEA.
- b) A reference letter showing applicant's demonstration of character, community service, and dedication of goals.
- c) Most recent certified transcript from an accredited educational institution and SAT scores if applicable.
(Applicant to attach transcript to application)
- d) Only a fully completed application will be taken into consideration.

*Only scholarship recipients will be notified.

Application deadline: August, 25th 2017

Award: \$1,000 scholarships to be presented at the Women and Education Scholarship Awards Dinner for recipients at a later date to be determined. All recipients must be present to receive the award.
